Monte-Carlo, 18 Sept 2014.

In the beautiful atmosphere of the XI Century Saint Sylvester Basilica, the oldest church in Tivoli (Rome, Italy), on 13 September afternoon, it was signed by both sides the protocollary agreement between the Imperial and Royal House Tchernetchich of Montenegro and Macedonia, and the Chivalric Association of Saint Sylvester Pope.

In the solemn ceremony, Monsignore Canonico Don Luigi Francesco Casolini, Rector and President of the noble Association, addressed the distinguished guests emphasizing the lines and reasons of this special event, bestowing His Imperial and Royal Highness Stephan, Prince of Montenegro and Macedonia, with the Grand Collar of the Association. After the touching ceremony, Prince Stephan appointed Monsignore Casolini with the Knighthood and Collar of the “Dynastic Order of Merit of the Golden Eagle”, the title of “Prince of the Crown of Montenegro” and style of “Most Serene Highness”.

Addressing His Imperial Highness, The Most Reverend President, pointed out how important is for all of us to understand the deep actions of our Lord Jesus Christ, who went to our world not to be served but to serve. “The real nobility is in our Christian way of life, in our everyday’s actions with the others”, emphasized Monsignore.
